Matches will be played by halves, thirds, but max: 5 competitors per group in round robin format, boys-girls group division.

In case of a tie, the final match will be played.

The KATA competitions will be conducted on a straight elimination basis in the above categories, with a boy-girl (male-female) group division.

8. Competition rules:

- According to the rules of the MKSZ competition (knock-down, kata).
- Kata competition rules, and layout of the competition area in the annex (pg 6-8).

9. Protective equipment:

For children and adolescent categories:

Leg protectors, head protectors, hand protectors (2-finger or 5-finger gloves), groin protectors for boys, lower body protectors for girls, chest protectors (must not cover the stomach area), and mouthguards allowed.

Youth and junior categories:

Leg protectors, head protectors, groin protectors for boys, lower body protectors for girls, chest protectors, and mouthguards allowed.

Adult category "C":

Compulsory protective equipment for women: breast protectors, lower body protectors, shin guards. The use of mouthguards is allowed.

For men, compulsory protective equipment: groin protectors, shin guards. The use of mouthguards is permitted.

Senior category:

Compulsory protective equipment for men: groin protectors, shin guards, headgear and mouthguards.

Protective equipment is provided by the competitors themselves.

- Entries must be received by the closing date

- Budo Pass valid for the year 2023 (stamp of the stylistic organization), with a valid sports doctor's "may compete" entry

- belt grade entry

- timely attendance at the on-site weigh-in.

- Competitors must have a declaration of consent to participate, for competitors under 18 years of age a declaration of consent from a guardian is required!

- After the deadline, all competitors must pay the entry fee (even if for whatever reason they cannot participate!)

- The transfer invoice for the entry fees will be issued and sent on 13.04.2023. If the transfer is not received by midnight on 14/04/2023, the entry will be invalid. In case of entries from foreign associations, payment can be made on site.

Kata competition order, order of presentation:

The competition will have 5 judges, 4 corner judges, and 1 referee.

The briefing judge /or person provided by the organizer/ will call the next two competitors to enter and stop at the fudo dachi at the designated place outside the competition area. At the call of the referee, they will greet: "Shomeni rei! Shushini rei! Otogani rei!", then at the Nakai chant, the called (aka) competitor enters the designated place inside the arena.

At the call of the referee /Kata!/, the contestant announces the name of the kata! The head referee will conduct the start and end of the kata in the usual manner for adult competitions.

On the command "sagate", he will leave the competition area and wait in fudo dachi for the opponent's kata to be presented. When the second competitor (shiro) has retired to his starting place outside the arena after completing his practice, the head referee and the corner judges will make the decision. On the signal of the whistle, they will give their opinion on which kata they consider to be the better kata by raising the flag of the appropriate colour. The head referee then announces the result based on the majority opinion. After the decision, the competitors salute and leave the tatami when the head referee calls for them to do so.

The order of the kata competition is according to the number of competitors:

no competition if there is 1 competitor (or, at the competitor's request, the competitor can enter a higher age group)

2, 3, 4, 5 competitors: round robin in one round, compulsory kata presentation

6, 8, 10 competitors:

- Round 1 - compulsory kata (straight elimination)
- Round 2 - optional kata (round robin)

One of the optional kata is sufficient to know.

In case of 7, 9 entries:

- Round 1 - compulsory KATAS (straight elimination, 1 advantage)
- Round 2 - optional KATAS (round robin)

One of the optional KATAS is enough to know.

Kata will be played in groups of max: 10 players.
